

## Privacy Notice for Californians

This Privacy Notice for California residents serves to inform California residents regarding the information that Cantaloupe, Inc. (collectively, "Cantaloupe," "we," "us," or "our") collects and applies solely to website visitors, business customers and contacts, users, and others who reside in the State of California ("consumers" or "you"). This Privacy Notice applies to data collection by Cantaloupe and shall apply to your use of the website, [www.usatech.com](http://www.usatech.com), and other Cantaloupe-related sites, applications, software, communications, capabilities and services ("Services") accessible on or by any top-level Cantaloupe domain owned by us (each, a "Site" and collectively the "Sites"). We adopt this notice to comply with the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 ("CCPA") and other California privacy laws.
